An Overview of NKI Research Efforts

NephCure Kidney Network Patient Registry

NKI maintains the NKN patient registry in order to accelerate research and increase participation in clinical trials by collecting patient-provided information. De-identified data is then made available to researchers to generate novel ideas for investigation.

Conferences

NKI supports and convenes a variety of scientific conferences and meetings to accelerate new research programs that will benefit our patient community.

Clinical Trials

NKI strives to increase our patient community's participation in clinical trials through education efforts and the NephCure Kidney Network patient registry. Increased participation in clinical trials reduces recruitment barriers that drive up the cost of new drug development programs.

Research Accelerator Meetings

NKI brings together representatives from academic medical centers and biopharmaceutical companies to exchange knowledge that will accelerate drug development.

Glomerular Consortia

NKI supports long-term glomerular disease studies conducted through four large multi-institution consortia. These studies track the patient journey over time to discover the causes of nephrotic syndrome and glomerular diseases and identify promising treatments.

Research Grants

NKI funds scientific researchers seeking the genetic and pathological causes of FSGS and Nephrotic Syndrome diseases in order to develop better treatments sooner.

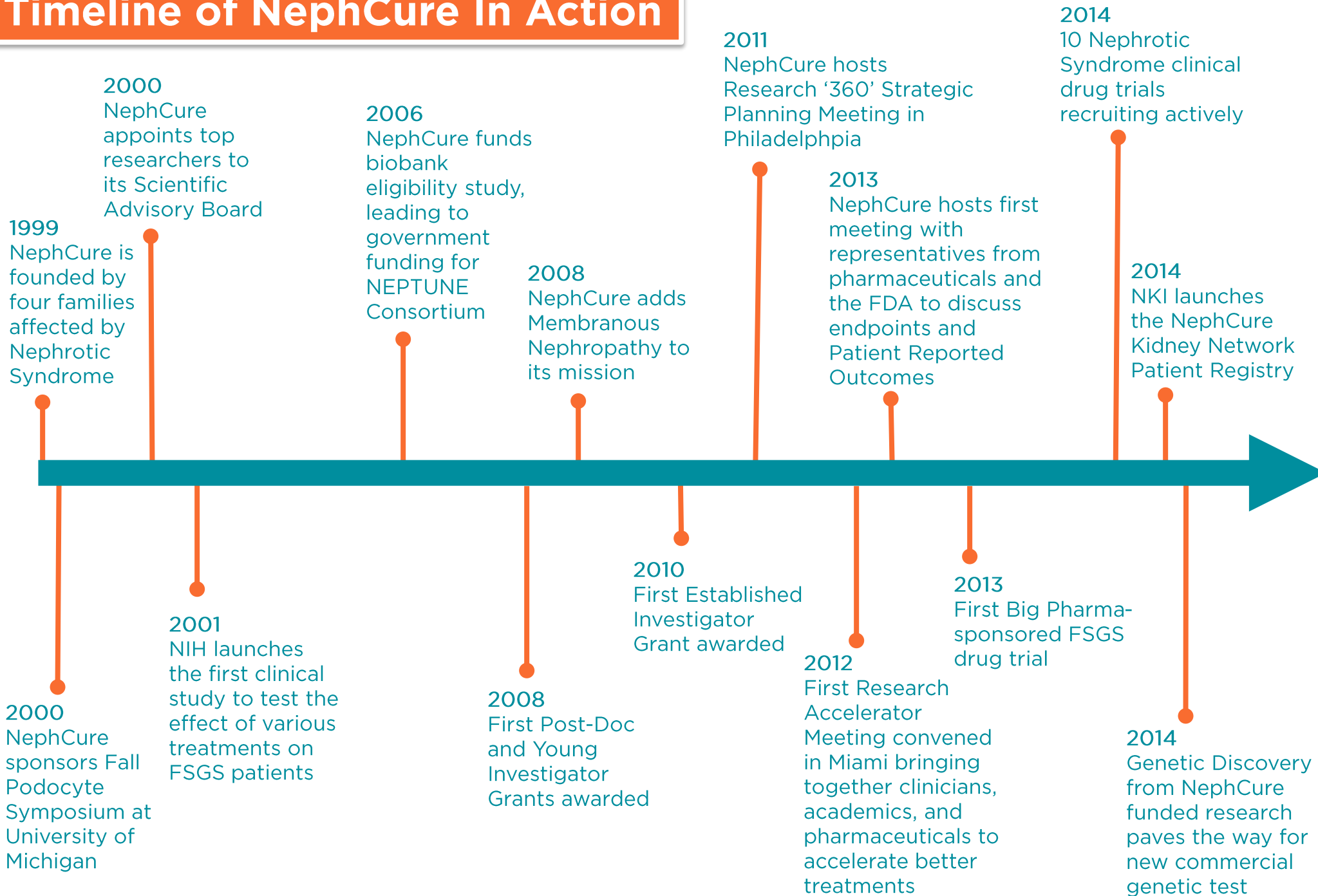

Engagement with Government

NKI works with federal officials at the NIH, NIDDK, and the FDA to promote government funding for glomerular disease research.

NephCure has committed \$13 million for 43 research projects over the past 12 years.
